

The Intention Imprinting Process Developed by Dr Tiller

The Imprinting Target

The imprinting process uses a carefully developed intention that is imprinted into an Un-Imprinted Electronic Device (UED), allowing it to serve as the host for the intended purpose of the intention. This is the “target” The Tiller Foundation uses.

Imprinting Is a Sacred Process

Always consider imprinting a sacred process. In Dr. Tiller’s words: “we always considered the imprinting as a sacred process and that higher intelligences in the ‘unseen’ universe did most of the real work. In this way, our imprint statement could be considered as something like a prayer.”

The Imprinting Session - Preparation

Choose a time and place for the imprinting session. Then assemble two or more accomplished meditators who are able to maintain a deep state of inward focus or meditation. The Tiller Foundation places the target (in this case a The Tiller UED) in the center of the group, plugged in and turned on. A table top works well. Turn off telephones and anything else that might provide a distraction. Sit quietly, eyes closed and enter a quiet communion with each other. Then expand that to include the “unseen” and the local universe. When this communion feels right and heart-connected, cleanse the local environment and any prior imprints or entanglements associated with the intention target(s). Then, attention is given (for ~ 4-5 minutes) to creating a “sacred” space around the target(s) where the specific intention is to be imbedded. This can be a statement agreed on beforehand and done silently, or spoken with

eyes closed, maintaining the inward focus. The Tiller Foundation reads the Precursor Cohering Statement for this.

The Imprinting Session – Reading The Statement

After the Precursor, reading of the intention statement follows. The entire intention statement is read by one of the meditators.

The Imprinting Session – Imprinting the Device

The intention statement is held in the mind and visualized with a strong emotional (heart-centered) content by the meditators for about 15 minutes.

Personal emotion contributes greatly to the imprinting process. Dr Tiller said: “*The power of the intention is strongly dependent on the emotional desire of the intender...emotions, like love, are fuel for the intention*”.

When the reader feels the imprinting is complete, the imprinting is then abruptly released as the reader verbally states “So be it! – Thy will be done!” Note: At this point The Tiller Foundation imprinters are queried by the reader to confirm that all agree the device is appropriately imprinted with the stated intention.

When it is agreed that this part of the imprint session feels complete then a final signal is given to shift focus to a secondary intention statement designed to seal the imprint charged into the device to minimize leakage. This is held by all for about 5 minutes and then abruptly released with the statement “So be it! – Thy will be done!”

Example of a Sealing Intention Statement

Read by one of the meditators.

Our subsidiary intention is that the prime directive imprint charge should remain with the IHD without any unnecessary leakage into the environment during either storage or activated device use. May they be sealed and protected against all outside interference through all time, all space, all planetary systems, all energy systems and all dimensions.
